Elective placements take place in Kilimatinde and Manyoni district hospital, this gives the opportunity to experience health care delivery in diverse and challenging settings and compare district and rural hospital provision.

Kilimatinde Hospital is a small rural mission Hospital

supported by charity funding. It serves remote village communities providing Outpatient services, postnatal and antenatal checks and general medical clinics. There is also a HIV testing and counselling facility within it. There is the capacity for 140 inpatients, male, female, children, obstetrics, and gynaecology. Kilimatinde have a flying doctor visit once a month and operate medical safari to vaccinate babies and do antenatal checks for mothers in remote areas.

Manyoni District Hospital serves a population of 33,000 people with an in reach and outreach service. In addition to the Clinics offered in kilimatinde, there are leprosy, TB, ophthalmology, Dental and Mental health clinics, they also provide physiotherapy and elderly care.
